Shooting Sports include archery, rifles and shot guns. You can sign up for each activity, with a separate cost for each one. Each scout can participate in 2 or 3 activities. The high COPE course, including high ropes and zip line, is one fee for the entire course. There is an age requirement of 13 years old for the COPE course.

In addition, there is a general camp fee for the trip itself, covering camp site, travel and food. There are also other camping activities, including campfire, fireside skits, and possibly a hike planned. This was one of the boys favorite camps last year.
